- 3. MTC FY 16/17 Budget:
 - a. Joel Rathje presented a Power Point regarding the recommendations being made to the committee.
 - i. It was suggested to keep projects that weren't initiated this past year to be put in a project "reserve" to be looked at possibly in the future.
 - b. Question about TOML Activity code 200 (Town Staff time), needing clarification about what this entails. Holler says that

 - d. Rich Boccia asked about the reserves and where that money came from.
 - e. Inyo Craters Shady Rest, question from Sandy Hogan, why did this "pop" back up and its priority: Holler and Rathje mentioned that they are looking at what they will bring to the Forest Service, and field work that will be done to consider whether this will eventually go to a NEPA process. Stroud mentioned this is the next area to consider.
 - f. Question about signs, maps and trail guides as being called "Capital,"
 - g. Who is the project lead?: Will be answered in the project initiation process. Need to answer who is capable, and things will change in the next few months.
 - h. Recommendation that we move this budget to MLR Board (M Page, S Brownlie, 4-0)
